#### **Scholarships Given**

As a non-profit organization, our Vision is to see a world filled with caring, connected communities and happy, loving families. To help promote the reality of our vision, we help families with reduced fee services and reduced fee educational opportunities.

#### Reduced Fee (Scholarship) Therapy Sessions

- 27 reduced-fee sessions worth \$80 / each \$2,160
- 126 pro-bono sessions worth \$ 100 / each \$12,600

#### Total therapy scholarships given \$ 14,760

Educational Scholarships - Supervised Visitation Training Program

- 191 scholarships (60% discount) worth \$413 / ea. = 78,883.
