

# Family & Children's Counseling Services Annual Report 2024

## **501(c)(3) Non-Profit Status**

Family & Children's Counseling Services obtained 501(c)(3) status on October 28, 2020, meaning that 2021 was our first official full year as a "nonprofit organization." Our primary source of income is "fee for service" therapy.

## **Fee for Service**

Fee for Service means a provider is paid for a service rendered. In our case, we are paid for each therapy service we provide. Our fees are appropriate according to industry standards. We accept some insurance, and we offer reduced fee and pro-bono options.

We did not solicit or receive donations, nor did we apply for or win grants in 2024.
